Legal Compliance

- Comply with all relevant environmental legislation, regulations, codes of practice and client-specific requirements.
- Monitor changes in environmental legislation and ensure compliance throughout our operations.

Pollution Prevention

- Take all reasonable steps to prevent pollution to land, watercourses, drainage systems and the atmosphere.
- Ensure fuels, oils, chemicals and other hazardous substances are stored, handled and disposed of correctly.
- Maintain appropriate spill response arrangements where required.

Waste Management

- Apply the principles of Reduce, Reuse and Recycle wherever reasonably practicable.

Carbon and Energy Reduction
